## March - Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month Activities

ARC's Self Advocates Becoming Empowered – Rutland (SABE-R) members worked hard in February preparing their presentations for the Disability Acceptance Clinics they planned to hold in March as part of Developmental Disabilities Awareness Month.

These clinics aim to educate professionals on how individuals with developmental disabilities have hopes and dreams just like everyone else and how they want to be treated with the same respect and kindness shown to other adults. Members also explain what accommodations they need to help them understand and fully participate in interactions with professionals such as health care workers, court staff, the police, and others.



To prepare, SABE-R members had to write their stories - their goals, the steps needed to achieve them, their accomplishments, and how they want to be treated, as well as any individual accommodations they need. They also had to practice introducing themselves and learn public speaking skills, which was very challenging and uncomfortable for them at first. With each presentation, the members became more confident

and eager to tell their stories and be heard. Family members reported seeing marked growth in their ARC member by their participation in these presentations.

Clinics were held at Park St. Healthshare, Rutland Superior Court, and Vermont State University Castleton Campus (we also hope to schedule clinics with the Rutland City Police Dept. and Project Vision soon).

SABE-R members also presented to Maggie O'Brien from the Rutland Regional Planning Commission (RRPC) as to what the needs and desires are of those with developmental disabilities, so the RRPC can try to address them in the 2026 Regional Plan. In addition, SABE-R participated in a focus group for Jaime Bentley from Rutland Regional Medical Center regarding their health planning.
