All drivers and their vehicles are thoroughly checked to meet our safety and privacy standards.


PROGRAM ELIGIBILITY

Riders must be 60 years of age or older or live with an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) defined disability, and reside within Rutland County.





FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who are our volunteers?

Volunteer drivers are dedicated Rutland locals, verified through background and DMV checks, plus a vehicle safety inspection.

Do I need to call ahead?

Yes, please call ahead <u>at least</u> 48 hours before your preferred departure time so we can best determine how to serve you!

Can I schedule multiple stops per trip?

Yes! We encourage riders to schedule multiple stops on the same trip so that they can get everything they need to get done at once!

Can we make an unscheduled stop?

The safety of our drivers, riders, and all others on the road is of the utmost importance to us. Therefore at this time, our drivers cannot permit unscheduled stops.

Is priority given based on trip type?

Yes, Critical Care riders are given priority access to rides due to the urgency of their medical needs.

HOW MANY TRIPS AM I ELIGIBLE FOR?

Critical Care riders are eligible for unlimited medical rides. For other riders, we invite you to call us for more details about our program guidelines.
